Guidelines for Parade Participants

1. Applications should be mailed in by April 24, 2010. Applications will still be accepted after this date.
2. Each entry shall be in “good taste” and shall, in the opinion of the judges add beauty and interest from the public point of view.
3. Each entry should display a sign or banner indicating affiliations.
4. Floats should bear the name of the community, organization, company, or individual responsible for its entrance in the parade on the side.
5. Participants must take and keep place assigned by the Parade Committee until the parade’s official termination.
6. Please keep a distance of three car lengths between you and the entry in front of you.
7. All vehicles should display their assigned entry number in a readable manner. A small hand-written sign (6 inches by 8 inches) in a window or taped to the side of the vehicle is recommended.
8. Each entry will make a stop in front of the Grand Stand while your entry is being announced.
9. The parade forms up on CM Allen between Hopkins and Cheatham.
10. Public Works will barricade connecting streets along the route a minimum of one hour in advance of the parade. There will be no vehicle traffic on the route once barricades are in place.
11. Throwing candy from vehicles or floats will be prohibited, although walkers may hand out treats.
